Semester end examination process:

S.S.S.Samiti,s Mahaveer P. Mirji college of commerce is affiliated to The Rani Channamma University (RCU), Belagavi, and conducts examinations as per the guidelines laid down by the university.

Here's a breakdown of the semester end exam process:

- 1. Registration and Admit Cards:
- Students register for semester-end examinations by submitting application forms and fees.
- The Registrar (Evaluation) office assigns a unique register number to each candidate for all subsequent examinations.
- Admit cards (exam tickets) are made available online, and candidates must ensure they have the correct admit card.

2. Conducting Examinations:

- During the examinations external deputy superintendents and squad teams appointed by the university visits the college to ensure smooth and fair conduct of exams.

3. Valuation and Results:

Answer scripts are sent to the RCU valuation centre where the evaluation takes place and results are announced by the University, including internal assessment marks submitted by colleges.

- Candidates can apply for revaluation or retotalling of answer scripts if they are not satisfied with the results.
- Revaluation results are also announced separately by the university.

The marks awarded for each paper shall be 100 out of which 20 marks will be internal assessment and remaining 80 marks will be for semester end examination.

The break down for 20 internal marks is, 3 marks are for attendance, 3 marks for assignment, 4 marks for first internal test and 10 marks for second internal test.

The marks awarded for each paper shall be 100 out of which 40 marks will be internal assessment and remaining 60 marks will be for semester end examination.

The break down for 40 internal marks is, 10 marks are for assignment, 10 marks for Seminar, 10 marks for first internal test and 10 marks for second internal test.
